Orientation- Admissions-Academic Planning

For all students who would like to participate in the SLCC Concurrent Enrollment Program, proceed to the website listed below, follow the steps and watch the videos for orientation, admissions, and academic planning.

Complete Steps 1 through 5 under the Student/Parent tab

The Orientation video series will take students through the entire admissions process and explain how to get started in the SLCC Concurrent Enrollment Program.

Once the student has completed the Orientation video series, he/she may also watch the Academic Planning videos. The Academic Planning videos are for any student who is working towards one of the three goals listed below.

If the student's goal is to:

- take a few concurrent enrollment courses to build their college transcript
- work in the direction of a 1-year Certificate of Completion
- work in the direction of a 2-year Associate Degree

After watching the Academic Planning video series the student should complete his/her own academic plan using the resources and printable handouts available below the videos.

Upon completion of his/her academic plan, the student will be prompted to save a copy for themselves and then email his/her academic plan, as an attachment, to concurrentadvising@slcc.edu. The advisor will review his/her plan for accuracy and send a confirmation to the student along with any additional comments or questions.
